Intercultural Course in Berlin (Reference Number : DE-2012-1165-003)

Most members of the Comparative Research Network are engaged in border research. Here the cultural implications of crossing borders are more than clear. Border research shows that intercultural competence is the key for good neighbourly relations across borders - but even more for multicultural urban places, like Berlin.

With this course Berlin will become a "stage" for the presentation, discussion and comparison of issues such as intercultural communication, cultural diplomacy, multicultural neighborhood engagement as well as skills and methods of intercultural work and experiences of practitioners from all over Europe.

We will give the floor to migrants and professionals in Berlin who will talk about their everyday practical experiences with intercultural work. Together with them we will

explore Berlin on excursions and witness the reality in neighborhoods like Kreuzberg, Neukölln or Wedding.

Our first course took place in March 2011 with professionals from more than 16 countries. We welcome you to Berlin and look forward to creating with you a denser network and to develop ideas for European projects.
